The recertification programme should be simple and easy to achieve for most clinicians who are competent and who do not have a history of complaints or recurring noncompliant behaviour. The yearly recertification is too frequent and makes it difficult for clinicians who may be having extended leave due to family commitments, recovering from an accident or illness, or have taken extended leave for a 'sabbatical' or 'overseas' trip. The need to for the following items :- a professional peer, a written PDP, a reflective statement, online open book assessment - should be only necessary where there has been a complaint or non compliant behaviour or a concern has been raised. This is an additional burden of time, and stress to clinicians - who are already overburdened with the increasing compliance issues around the running of a practice, cross infection control, health and safety in the workplace etc etc These measures should only target clinicians where there are concerns. The current 4 yearly CPD cycle allows for a variety of professional development activities, in a number of different areas to be undertaken depending on what courses, workshops, conferences, etc are on offer locally for each clinician during that timeframe. In a single year there may be limited options in some aspects of dentistry - and therefore an inability to cover a desired topic. Peer contact in multi clinician practices happens on a daily basis.
