Summary of Decisions

From the Dental Council meeting - 7 October 2013

The Dental Council is the statutory body constituted under the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 (The Act) to maintain the health and safety of members of the public by providing mechanisms to ensure that health practitioners are competent and fit to practise. Council endeavours to keep its key stakeholders up to date with key decisions. This document is a summary of Council's decisions from the meeting held in October 2013.

Medical Emergencies code of practice – Expert Team

National Dental Examining Board of Canada

Council resolved that a formal process be initiated to explore a partnership with the National Dental Examining Board of Canada for Council's New Zealand Dentist Registration Examination process.

Council appointment

Accreditation - Otago University Annual Report

The Dental Council approved the accreditation review team's recommendation, and accepted the 2012 annual reports as satisfactory in meeting the requirements for:

- Bachelor of Dental Technology and Bachelor of Dental Technology (Honours)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Dental Technology

The Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Dental Technology programme accreditation status would also change to full accreditation until 31 December 2015.
