AUT Bachelor of Health Science (oral health) programme - targeted monitoring review

The Council brought forward the accreditation period for the Auckland University of Technology Bachelor of Health Science in Oral Health programme from 31 December 2023 to 31 December 2022 – with a full accreditation review during quarter three of 2022 to monitor all aspects of the accreditation standards.

This would allow time for the programme to address the known and identified issues. In the interim, conditions are placed on the programme to ensure the accreditation standards are being met. Full details on the targeted review outcome are available in the outcome report.
